**ACTION: *IN-CAMERA* HEARING**

2:05 P.M. Conference call (above counsel present) and counsel for Gennifer Flowers, Ruggar Burke, included in conference call.

Court takes up matter of counsel's dispute re: release of deposition video of Gennifer Flowers. Ettinger advises Court that Flowers' counsel wants a copy of the video deposition and indicates he understood there are offers to purchase video. Burke indicates no current offers to sell video.

Pike, for Jones, stated he has no comments on this but assures Court he will not do anything to violate Court's order.

Burke stated they had been told they could have a copy of video deposition.

Court advises parties that it does not know what it would do if video was made public and states purpose of order issued was to ensure a fair trial; Court states options available to ensure a fair trial. Court would like some assurance that video tape would not be released until after trial so as not to influence potential jurors.

Statements from Graves concerning Pike agreeing to allow to have a Burke copy of video; Burke states he would not release video to public without an order from the Court, but cannot agree for Flowers.

Court directs Burke to go and talk with her to get her agreement as well.

Jones' counsel advises Court that Burke asked for a copy of video tape and was told he would need to work out with videographer in order to get a copy.

After further discussions regarding release of video, Burke left conference to speak with Flowers.

Court takes up matter *in camera* with counsel in absence of Burke re: Cindy Hays issue. Court has received a response to mot from Clinton's counsel and now something has filed something related to Paul Jones Legal Defense Fund. Ettinger responds that motion is now ready for ruling. Court also states there is a motion to quash or modify subpoena. Ettinger will contact Amy Sabrin and get back with Barry today to be sure it is ready for ruling.

Court takes up motion filed by Jones asking for expedited response re: interrogatories and inquires of Clinton's counsel if they can respond in allotted time. Counsel responds and Court will allow to respond in normal allotted time.

Burke returned to conference call and indicated he has talked with Flowers. He represents that if allowed to have a copy of video tape, it will not be released until Court order allowing to do so. All counsel agree this is satisfactory.

Court states reasons for not wanting to release tape to public.

Kathy Graves will make conference call at 5:30 next week in Jonesboro.
