**ACTION: *IN-CAMERA HEARING***

4:05 p.m. Conference call (above counsel present). Court states Bristow contacted Court from car phone and whatever is decided by Bennett is okay with him.

Bennetts states purpose of phone conference. He has just left President and he requests that Judge attend in person the deposition on Saturday; states it is a critical deposition and may be only testimony at trial and is concerned about counsel's tactics and anticipates strong objections but feels objections are not strong enough protection in this matter and wants Judge there; states additional reasons for requesting attendance.

Court asks for response from pltf's counsel.

State they do not object if Court feels appropriate but thinks Bennett should have contacted them about this.

Court states concerns about getting there and wants law clerk present; Court would need to pay for this.

Court advises that it believes it would be better to be present to make rulings and will be willing to go to Washington and set at deposition and make rulings. Court advises parties of ground rules with respect to video as relates to Court — does not want to be on camera and should only focus on witness or lawyer.

Additional discussions and suggestions of how the Court can avoid media attention in arriving for deposition. Court will contact US Marshal re: security for her.
