MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER AND
DESIGNATION AS JANE DOE

Petitioner Jane Doe ("Jane Doe") moves for a protective order designating her as a Jane Doe pursuant to Rules 7(b) and 26(c) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and in support states:

1. In [REDACTED] 1997, Jane Doe was served with a subpoena duces tecum by plaintiff's counsel to appear for a deposition in Little Rock, Arkansas.
